The current state of affairs, specifically the situation with the Novel Coronavirus (COVID-19), has likely led to questions about the impact this is going to have on the events and what actions the I-X Center is implementing at our facility.

As part of our commitment to the wellbeing of our staff, promoters and attendees, we are carefully monitoring reports from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and will continue to remain in contact with medical advisors and health agencies. We will continue implementing preventive measures for the health and safety of everyone entering the I-X Center. When visiting, please know, our team is here to answer any questions or concerns that may arise and have the following health and safety protocols in place:

- Reinforce and increase daily cleaning procedures with use of disinfectant products on all high-touch surfaces and high-traffic areas.
- Provide easily accessible automatic hand sanitizer dispensers and pump bottles throughout the facility.
- Continued education for our team on best practices recommended by the CDC.
- Quick response to spills, trash and other situations.

Additionally, we advise everyone to adhere to the CDC's recommendation of everyday preventive actions to stop the spread of germs, such as:

- Stay home when sick.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds.
- Use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol if soap and water are not available.
